**<Import P2(OP-1b)>**  
 ① Select [CONTENTS≠AVCLIP] folder of a P2 card on Source Browser to display thumbnails.

**<Import P2(OP-Atom)>**  
 ② Select [CONTENTS≠VIDEO] folder of a P2 card on Source Browser to display thumbnails.

③ Select clips.  
 ④ Click [Link] button.
