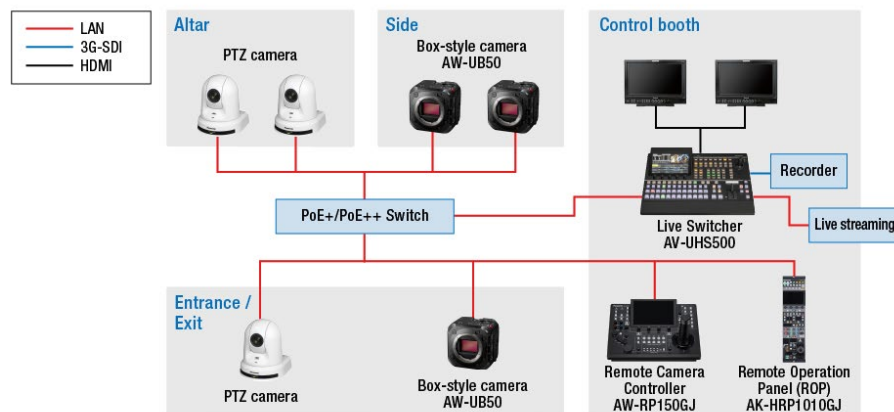
It is possible to capture shots with a shallow depth of field, which would be difficult to achieve with a standalone PTZ camera, resulting in a powerful and impactful video that will touch your heart.

Production and Effects

In chapels where setting up tripods for filming is difficult, not only on the altar but also in the side and back aisles, installing PTZ cameras allows for smooth filming without disrupting the wedding ceremony.

Additionally, by using box-style cameras alongside PTZ cameras, it becomes possible to capture shots with a shallow depth of field, which would be challenging with PTZ cameras alone, resulting in deeply moving footage.

System Configuration Diagram

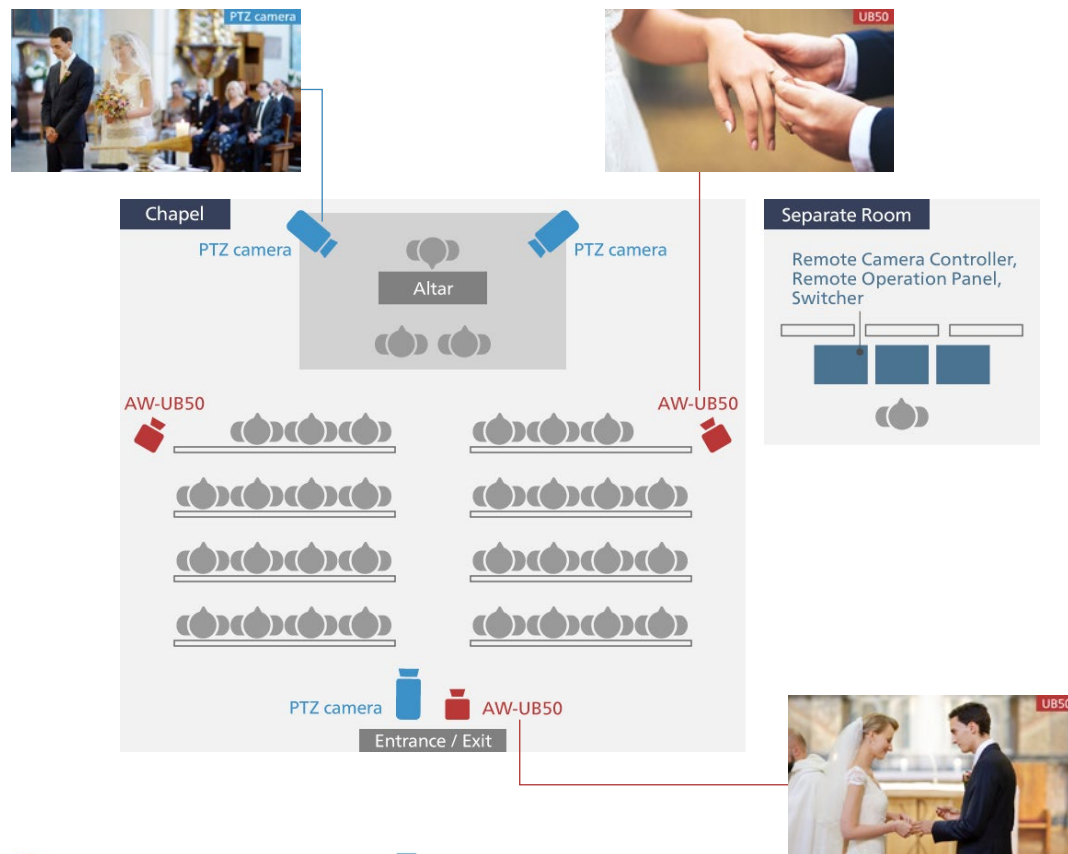


AW-UB50 + PTZ Camera



Equipment Configuration and Installation Location

AW-UB50 x 3

One camera is placed above the entrance for telephoto close-ups of the couple, while two side cameras cover the altar from both the left and right angles.

PTZ Camera x 3

Two cameras are installed behind the altar on the left and right sides, with one additional camera positioned near the entrance doors.
