

# Guide for AG-CX350 clip import from SD,P2 card on (Win) Media Composer Ver.2019.11

**<Import P2(OP-1b)>**  
 ① Select [CONTENTS\AVCLIP] folder of a P2 card on Source Browser to display thumbnails.  
**<Import P2(OP-Atom)>**  
 ② Select [CONTENTS\VIDEO] folder of a P2 card on Source Browser to display thumbnails.  
 ③ Select clips.  
 ④ Click [Link] button.

**<Import AVCHD>**  
 ① Select [PRIVATE¥STREAM] folder in a SD card on Source Browser to display thumbnails.

**<Import MOV>**  
 ② Select [PRIVATE¥PANA\_GRP¥subfolder(e.g. 001RFQAM)] in a SD card on Source Browser to display thumbnail.

③ Select clips.  
 ④ Click [Link] button.
