<Import P2(OP-Atom)>

- ① Select parent folder of [CONTENTS] folder in a media drive or P2 card.
- ② Click [Link] button.

- ① Select [PRIVATE¥STREAM] folder in a SD card on Source Browser to display thumbnails.

<Import MOV>

- ② Select [PRIVATE¥PANA_GRP¥subfolder (e.g. 001RFQAM)] in a SD card on Source Browser to display thumbnail.

- ③ Select clips.
- ④ Click [Link] button.
