

Guide for AG-CX350 Ver.3.0 clip import on -from P2 card- (Mac) DaVinci Resolve Studio 16 Ver.16.2

<Import P2(OP-Atom)>

- ① Thumbnails in a P2 card are displayed on Media Page.
- ② Select clips and import them by drag and drop into a bin.

Please separate PRIVATE folder from CONTENTS folder to import. P2 is not recognized if PRIVATE folder exists. (Version 16.2.5 fixes this issue.)

Import by drag and drop clips into a bin.
