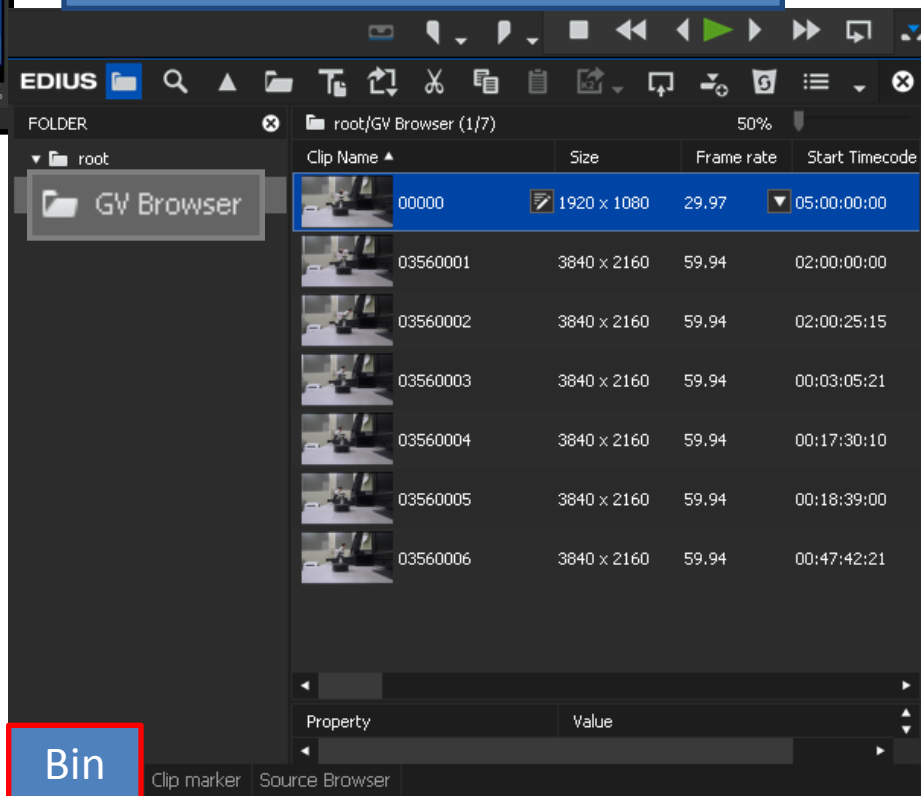

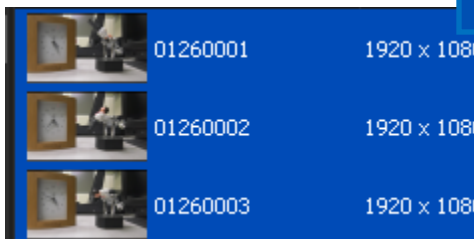
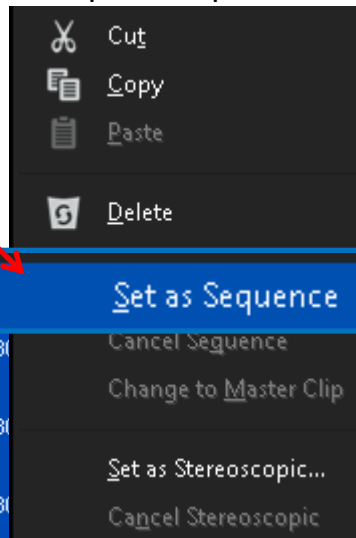
Clips are now imported into a bin.

In the case of MOV/MP4 file-spanned clip, please do the following method to put on a sequence for the proper audio playback at the spanned portion.

- 1) Line clips in order of playback in the bin.
- 2) Select all the clips.
- 3) Right-click and do "Set as Sequence".
- 4) Clips are unified.
